Volunteer

When? Every week on your chosen day from **7:30am to 8:30am**.* You may also choose every other week or less, but consistency is best and the key to building trust.

How? We aim to serve the children joyfully and respectfully, to bless them with food and love as they begin their day. Ask the Holy Spirit how He wants to work through you each time you come.

Why? We are called to serve children (Matt 18:1-5, 19:13-15), and perform acts of justice in our local community (Micah 6:8).

Who? You will be helping Kenny Hale and Malea, a social worker who leads the program. Please wear a

nametag from the church each week so everyone knows who you are.

Where? Enter the lobby of the school through the front doors. Please remain in the lobby and do not wander in the hallways.

What? Wash hands and help as needed! Serve bagels, spread jam or cream cheese, pour water or milk. If you have time, it's wonderful to sit down by the kids and talk to them a bit before they start class.

What not to do? Please do your best not to touch the children. Also, please stay home if you have a contagious illness.

What else? Please get your police background check forms from the church and get that completed within your first month of volunteering. Thank you!
